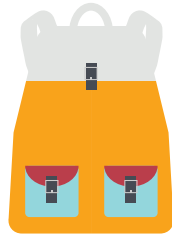
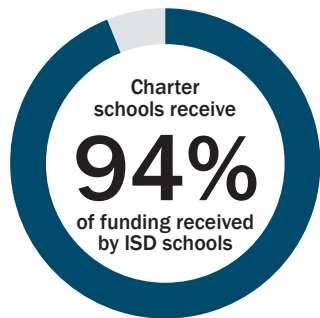


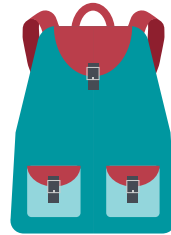
Do Texas charter schools get more money than ISD schools?

Charter schools receive less money.

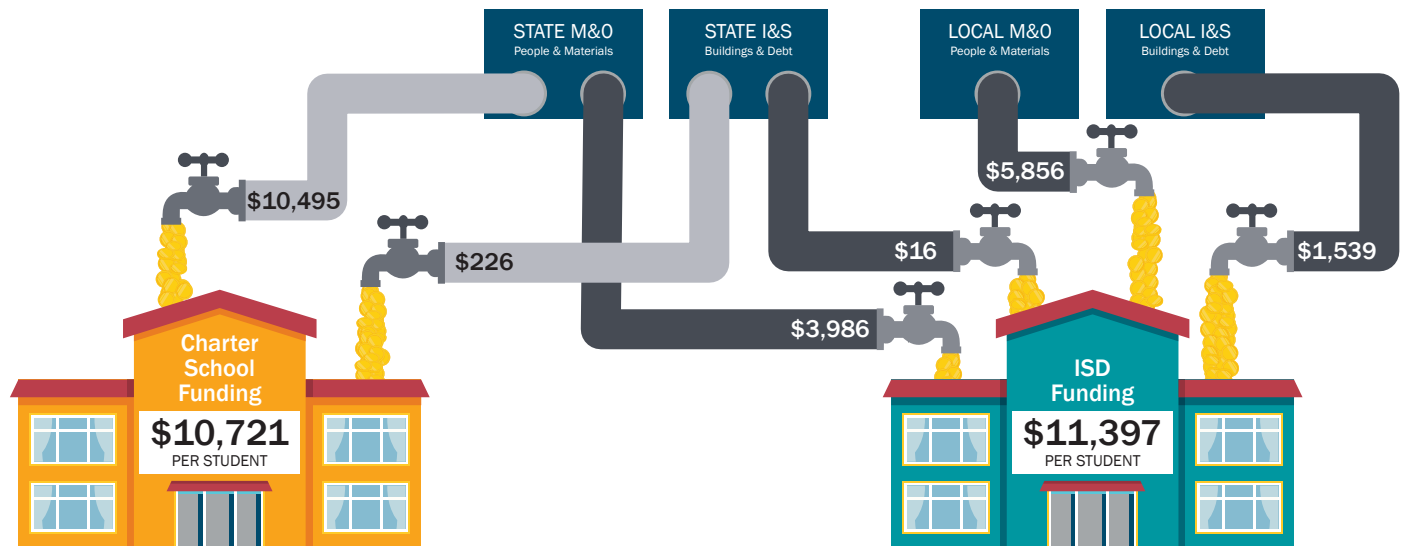


\$10,721
per charter school student

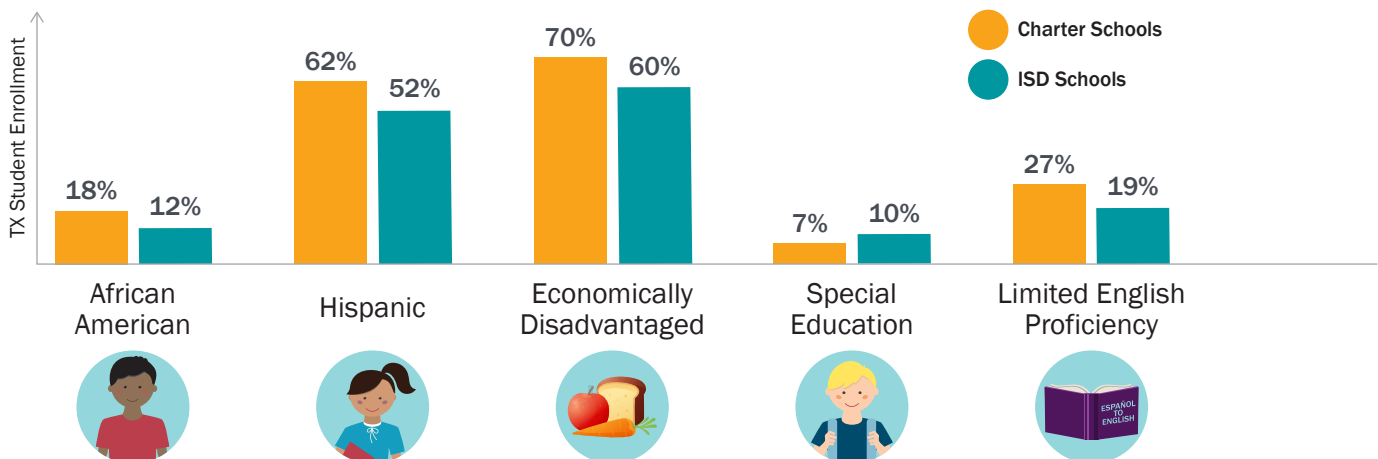


\$11,397
