Board Meeting Report Special Programs Report 2/15/22 From Aaron Ball, Director of Special Programs

**41** Current Special Programs Students

Eligibility Criteria includes Autism, Intellectual Disability, Speech Impairment, Other Health Impairment: ADHD, Emotional Disturbance (ED), Specific Learning Disabilities, Tourette Syndrome

- 23 504 students. These students receive accommodations in the classroom and/or dyslexia services
- 1 student 1:1 all day. He has an aide or teacher with him at all times throughout the day
- 2 students receive 1:1 behavior support for 3 hours or more
- 2 Dedicated Full-time Special Programs Aides
- 1 Part time Aide
- 2 Full-time Special Education Teachers (behavior support teacher position open)

E-therapy for social skills groups will start on 2/16 to ensure IEP minutes are given until a permanent behavior support teacher is hired

### **TEA**

Supporting documentation for corrections is finished. CAP monitoring has started. 1st phase (timelines for evals and initials) started.

Dyslexia submission was completed. Requested documentation was submitted on 12/9/21. Parent notification of screeners has been included in the Newsletter. School website has been

updated with the new Dyslexia handbook and information for parents. These are part of the corrective actions requested from TEA.



February, 2022, School Board Report Submitted by Roberta Givens, School Improvement Coordinator

#### **Assessment Activities:**

Students were administered the Middle of the Year MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) Growth assessments for both math and reading. Make-up sessions were held for those students who were absent. Results will be shared and discussed with parents during parent conferences.

The "Dyslexia Screener" portion of the TPRI (Texas Primary Reading Inventory) was administered to all first grade students as required by TEA, and the results were shared with Guides and parents. Students who received a "Still Developing" score indicates that those students are still developing phonological and phonemic awareness and may be at-risk for Dyslexia. These students have been added to the Child Study team, will receive reading intervention activities within the Communities, and their progress will be closely monitored to determine if further testing is needed.

#### 2022-2023 STAAR Redesign and Field Testing:

Several requirements of House Bill 3906, 86th Texas Legislature, 2019 are influencing a redesign of the STAAR that will be implemented in the 2022-2023 school year. This redesign will include several components:

- Transitioning to online assessments
- Adding writing to reading/language arts (RLA) assessments
- Capping the number of multiple choice questions
- Adding new item types

Schools across the state were selected to participate in field testing to properly integrate these new components into future state assessments. All 6th grade students were provided an opportunity to complete the 6th grade Reading Language Arts (RLA) Stand Alone Field Test utilizing the STAAR secure browser on student Chromebooks. Local Education Agencies will not receive any results or data from this test. However, as a routine part of the test development process for the Texas Assessment Program, field-test questions and data will be reviewed to determine whether the questions are appropriate for inclusion in the test bank. In addition, no performance information for students, campuses, districts, or the state will be provided for this field test.

Guides and assistants will receive training regarding the STAAR Assessment Program during Staff Development on February 18, 2022.

## **Tutoring Program:**

Because our third graders will take the STAAR assessment for the first time this year, we have begun providing extra tutoring for students on Saturdays (math, led by Jordan Young) and after school on Wednesdays (reading, led by Jackie Templeton). The tutoring sessions are designed to provide students with opportunities to become familiar with, and practice utilizing, the embedded tools and resources available to all students within the online testing environment. Plans may include expanding these tutoring sessions to other grade levels.



# Board Meeting Report Marketing and Recruiting Report February 22, 2022 From Kristi Lee

### **Marketing:**

Marcy is designing a postcard to be printed. We have a plan using USPS to choose routes that the postcard will be sent to in surrounding areas.

We have brochures that Chris Hinds' company designed that we are using at prospective family nights and will use at the Poppy Festival.

We've sent in the form for the Poppy Festival and chosen a booth near the children's activities. They are billing us, and we will be listed as a sponsor with additional advertising included. The sign-up for the parade has not been published; we are on the list to receive it.

I am taking flyers to area businesses that allow us to post. The local libraries, the toy store in downtown Georgetown, downtown Round Rock coffee shops are target areas.

### Marketing and recruiting for new hires:

We are currently interviewing candidates for a behavior specialist, an upper elementary guide, and an assistant.

I'm using Indeed, Linked In, local universities, NCMPS (<u>National Center for Montessori in the Public Sector</u>) and Montessori Facebook sites to advertise.

### **Communications:**

Recently we've updated several other areas concerning special education, dyslexia, and 504. The most recent dyslexia handbook and the special education and 504 policies have been added. We created content specifying how to apply for next year and the timeline of the registration process. Along with prospective family meeting times and dates, we have also included information on how the lottery and waitlist work.

Covid Report

School Programs Coordinator

Williamson County remains in the Red Phase of Covid19 transmission and experiencing a surge of the Omicron Covid variant. A decline in Covid cases, hospitalizations and deaths are being reported at this time for our county.

During the week of Monday (2/7) and Sunday (2/13) the school documented a total of 1 confirmed Covid19 case among staff and students. This has brought our cumulative case number up to 75 for the school year so far. We are now experiencing a sharp decrease in Covid19 confirmed cases and absences due to covid related symptoms.

Goodwater continues to institute Covid-19 protocols of mask-wearing, distancing, and hand hygiene. Families have been exceptional in mitigating the spread by completing Covid-19 symptoms assessments regularly and monitoring their children for symptoms.



## Instruction and Curriculum Report Submitted by Sandy Worcester 02/22/2022

- 3rd grade parents have been surveyed to indicate interest in their children receiving tutoring to prepare for the computer administered Reading STAAR.
   This will be offered February 16-March 9. STAAR Math tutoring began February 12. Eight students are expected to attend.
- Professional Development February 18 will include training on BookNook, our RTI Reading Curriculum for Multi-tiered System of Supports Tier 2 and Tier 3 identified students. Also Guides will be reviewing and analyzing their MAP Winter 2022 Data to use in forming groups and scheduling their RTI in class sessions.
- TELPAS: Katy Ford-Metzler will be assessing K/1 students holistic rating, and Sharon Garcia, Liliana Pinzon, and Melvin Blackburn will be rating written composition samples given to students by their Guides. Deadline for collecting writing samples is February 28. The rating of the writing samples will take place March 7.
- STAAR Benchmark Interim assessment for grades 3-8 will take place March 1 and 2.

#### **COVID UPDATE**

- 1. As of Monday, February 14th, we have had a total of 75 COVID cases for the 2021-2022 school year. We continue to see a lower number of COVID cases.
- 2. We have also had two cases of Influenza Flu Type A and B. We will continue to monitor flu cases during this spring. There are no new updates from the CDC or WCCHD.
- I want to commend our staff for the incredible work they are doing during this latest
  uptick in COVID cases. The work our staff does to continue providing support for our
  students and families and the flexibility they show each and every day never go
  unnoticed.

### **ACADEMICS**

- We have completed the Middle of Year (MOY) MAP Assessment. This report will be compared to the BOY so that we can determine additional Response to Intervention (RTI) requirements for our students for the balance of the 2021-2022 school year. These reports are being sent out to parents. Progress Report conferences will be held in March prior to Spring Break.
- 2. We continue to work with students who did not pass or did not take the STAAR Assessment in the spring of 2021, utilizing our Accelerated Instruction (AI). We are slightly behind due to the recent uptick in COVID exposure. We are seeing improvement for the students in Accelerated Instruction through ongoing benchmarks we are doing. Roberta Givens, our School Improvement Coordinator, and Sandy Worcester, Director of Curriculum and Instruction will be working with our RTI teacher to ensure that students continue receiving their tutorials.
- 3. We are also working on Tier 1 RTI (Response to Intervention) for students who are now showing deficiencies based on their work for this year. These Tier 1 interventions are done in the Community by the Guides.
- 4. We have also begun a Saturday Math Camp for students in the Third grade to receive additional instruction. Students will be receiving instruction in math, and also we will be assisting these students to use the computer so they will be prepared to take these Assessments online in May.
- 5. We started our after school Reading Camp last week for students in Third grade. These sessions are being taught by Ms. Jackie, one of our Lower Elementary Guides.
- Last week the 6th-grade students took a Field Test STAAR Assessment in Reading/Language Arts. This is based on the new STAAR Reading/Language Arts (RLA) Assessment that students will be taking beginning in the 2022-2023 school year.
