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## School Priorities for 2023-2024

While there were many obstacles in the previous years, our commitment to our students and families is that we are going to do everything we can to address learning loss and to move students toward the future. Our entire team has one mission this year and that is to provide a Montessori environment for our students.

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# Instructional Information for Families

Goodwater Montessori School continues to provide face-to-face learning for all students in the 2023-2024 school year. We are excited to have all of our students back to campus and do not anticipate offering remote learning this school year. We understand that there might be parents and caregivers who are concerned about new developments with regard to COVID-19 but we want to assure all of our parents and caregivers that we continue to monitoring the situation and will adapt as new information is provided to the CDC (Center for Disease Control) and WCCHD (Williamson County and Cities Health District).

### **Learning Tools**

Our school was founded on Montessori instruction and our plan is to continue to the roots of Montessori education by utilizing the materials that each community has been provided. Technology is a supplemental tool that is important and will be available to students at school as determined by the Guides and Curriculum team.

# **Protocols for Safe and Healthy Schools**

The school may need to change protocols at any time to address specific needs and circumstances in order to protect the health and safety of students, employees, and the community. Goodwater will continue to seek guidance from governmental agencies including the Williamson County and Cities Health District (WCCHD). The school will comply with applicable federal and state employment and disability laws, workplace safety standards, and Accessibility standards to address individual needs. Updates to safety protocols will be posted on our website as needed.



## **Protocols for Screening and Isolation**

**Screening Protocols** 

• Neither staff nor students should report to school/work if they are actively sick with Covid-19, who are suspected of being sick with Covid-19 as evidence of Covid-19 symptoms or who have received a positive Covid-19 test result.

**Isolation Protocols** 

• If students display symptoms of COVID-19 OR are feeling feverish, the school will provide a clinical assessment to determine if and when a student needs to be sent home.

#### Student & Staff Protocols

Students/Staff who have tested positive for COVID-19 may not attend school. They may return to campus when:

- 5 days have passed from symptom onset or from the date of the positive Covid19 test (if asymptomatic), AND
- Have improved symptoms, AND
- At least 24 hours have passed (without the use of fever reducing medication).

The return to campus date is the 6th date after symptom onset or positive Covid test, whichever comes first.



## **Protocols for Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)**

Schools are required to comply with the governor's executive orders regarding the wearing of masks. As of June 1, 2021 masks are optional for all students and staff.

### **Protocols for Disinfecting and Hand Washing**

Frequent disinfection and hand sanitization will contribute to the positive health and wellness of students and staff.

Hand Washing/Sanitizing Expectations

- Hand sanitizer is available at the main entrance to the school, in common areas, in each community, and the administrative office.
- Each community has access to an electrostatic sprayer to sanitize material in the community.
- Each community has an air purifier.
- Masks are available if a student would like one.
- Staff and students are expected to regularly wash or sanitize their hands.

### **Protocols for Cleaning and Disinfecting**

Frequent cleaning and disinfection support a healthy learning and work environment for students and staff. The school continues to supply adequate cleaning and disinfectant supplies for our facilities. Staff are trained on proper protocols.

### **Resources for Mental Health**

We have a counselor to provide support to students through large and small group instruction and/or working with classroom teachers to meet the personal/social needs of students.
